Program Description: The North Carolina State Board of Dental Examiners has ruled that coronal polishing is a legal function for DAI in training or DALLs as of June 7, 2024. Per 21 NCAC 16H. 0203(a), the dentist would be responsible for determining when a DAI in training can take a qualifying coronal polishing course. This course will include lecture, laboratory, and clinical practice in the skill of coronal tooth polishing. ****The AM will be lecture and the PM will be clinical.**** Upon completion of this course, the Dental Assistant I in training and the Dental Assistant II will be able to legally polish the coronal surfaces of the dentition, under the supervision of a licensed dentist. Participants must attend 100% of the program. No partial credit will be given.
