

## TIP SHEET FOR MAKING CLINICAL PLACEMENT REQUESTS



For All Requests, use the <u>Rotation Manager</u> Clinical Placement Platform

#### 1. Select

- Specialty: Rotation or Preceptorship
- Rotation Type: Instructor-led group, Float Assist, Observation, or Precepted
- Location: Start/End Date, DAY of Week- for Rotation, Start/End-Times
- Shift: Semester (Label), Type of Rotation,
- Rotation Label(s): Fall, Spring, or Summer; Course #
- 2. Please do not add repetitive or unnecessary information in the comments section. You may add a rotation label to indicate the course #. You may indicate fundamentals level vs. senior level.

#### 3. Instructor-led Group

- o Request separately for each student group
- o Do NOT request one overall time frame for more than one student group
- Request each clinical group SEPARATELY.
- o Confirm Clinical Instructor name prior to start date
- o Confirm student names prior to start date

### 4. Observation

- Request each slot separately
- Request each clinical day SEPARATELY
- o Confirm Clinical Instructor name prior to start date

#### 5. Float Assist

- Request each slot separately
- Request each clinical day SEPARATELY.
- o Confirm Clinical Instructor name prior to start date

#### 6. Preceptorship

- o Request each slot separately for each student
- Request each preceptorship separately, entering Start/End Dates
- Do not request class days
- Select 0700-0700 for Start/End Times to indicate availability for all shifts

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NURSING STUDENT ROTATION DEFINITIONS	
ROTATION TYPE	DETAILS
Instructor-led Clinical Group	<ul> <li>Instructor on-site.</li> <li>Clinical students should function within their scope of practice; schools will verify skills that students have been validated on.</li> </ul>
Float Assist	<ul> <li>Clinical Students are scheduled to float to your unit to spend a shift or number of hours there. The purpose is to expose them to unit skills and procedures.</li> <li>Students do not have to be paired one-to-one with/ the same Staff Nurse for the duration of the rotation.</li> <li>Students are not limited to observation; they are permitted to participate in hands-on activities within their scope of practice, ie. skills list.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>A Nursing Clinical Instructor will be on-site, as a point of contact, although not directly supervising the student. The student is floating from the primary clinical group assignment.</li> <li>EMS Instructors will be immediately available by phone.</li> </ul>
Observation	CI doesn't have to be present (on-site) at the healthcare facility. No hands-on care by the student. Observation only related to the curriculum for a one-time experience. Objectives must be given.
Precepted	<ul> <li>This is a one-to-one match of a student to a qualified Staff Member.</li> <li>Students will follow the schedule of the Staff Member.</li> <li>Clinical Students are permitted to administer medications under the direct supervision of their preceptor.</li> <li>Students may perform skills independently that have been validated by their school and healthcare facility.</li> <li>Each school has its own requirement for # hours that must be completed for the capstone. Some students may be required to fulfill several hours of leadership experience in addition to the</li> </ul>
